WHAT DOES NRG DO?

 - Industrial (manufacturing)
 - Energy (downstream gas, electricity and utilities)

 - Coal (coal mining)
- Research and news about HR policies and benchmarking, and other topics of interest relating to HR and remuneration.

We hold an annual conference where members meet and network with like-minded HR professionals and leaders to develop their professional skills. NRG members interact directly with each other throughout the year to keep abreast of hot topics and developments in their industry.

WHO CAN JOIN?

Membership of NRG is open to companies involved in the resources, energy or manufacturing industries within Australia. You must demonstrate your organisation is active in one or more of the relevant industry sectors and that you can match positions in at least one NRG sector survey.

HOW TO JOIN

Becoming a member is easy and you will be well supported through the application process. You must provide the committee with details including your company's size and scope of activities in Australia, and its ability to contribute to the benchmarking and salary surveys.

There are no joining fees or forms to complete. Annual membership is \$4,950 including GST for the year ending June 2019. The membership fee includes participation in all surveys and one person's attendance at the annual conference. Member companies are welcome to bring extra people to the conference at a small additional cost per person. Only current members are entitled to participate in the annual conference and surveys.

GOVERNANCE AND VALUES

Our association is managed by a committee elected annually by the members and governed by NRG's constitution.

The NRG management committee guides our annual activities with the help of external service providers such as Korn Ferry Hay Group, which collects and prepares our remuneration and benefits surveys.

OUR SURVEYS

Members regard our surveys as the most valuable and reliable of their kind. As they are designed largely by the members themselves, the surveys are relevant and user friendly, with confidentiality guaranteed. Each sector has its own survey covering positions defined by the sector. Other surveys covering the most common core positions, senior executive roles and HR policy and practice, are conducted across the entire membership. Survey inputs are collected in July each year, with reports and individual company-specific feedback reports published by the end of September. Additional surveys and custom analysis of data are available upon request.

OUR CONFERENCES

We hold an annual conference each year, normally in mid to late October. The conference program includes keynote sessions and workshops covering topical aspects of HR and remuneration practice. Each sector meets to discuss topics of general interest. The conference location varies, with this year's conference to be held at the Novotel Barossa Resort from 23-25 October 2019.
